1. Introductory Statement:

- 1.1. Scoil Mhuire gan Smál is committed to ensuring the privacy of all visitors to our website www.kilkerleyns.com.
- 1.2. This privacy statement relates to our practices in connection with our website, and is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect and safeguard the personal information you provide to us, and to assist you in making informed decisions when using our site and services.

2. Information (personal and non-personal) you choose to provide:

- 2.1. **IP Addresses** When you visit our website, the only information you provide to us is your IP Address. An IP address is a number that is assigned to your computer automatically when you use the internet. When you visit any webpage in our website, our servers log your IP address. Your IP address can be used to help identify you and to gather broad demographic information. We do not use your IP address, however, it may be given to law enforcement agencies if they request it as part of a criminal investigation
- 2.2. **Website Use Information** When you visit our website, certain personal and non-personal data is available to us through our internet service provider. This non-personal data is collected on a statistical, aggregate, non-individual basis. As mentioned previously, this information may include the IP address from which you access our website, the type of internet browser and operating system used, the top-level domain name used (.ie, .com, .org etc.), the date and time of your visit, and the number of pages you visited on our website.
- 2.3. **Cookies** A cookie is a small file sent to your browser from a web server and stored on your computer's hard drive to identify you as the user of the website. Our website, like most, uses cookies for functionality and performance. By using our website, you agree that we can place these types of cookies on your device. You can prevent websites using cookies in your browser settings, if desired. However you must note that this may stop our website from working properly on your device. If you do not change your browser settings to refuse cookies, our website will issue cookies when you visit our website. If you continue to use our website, you agree and consent to our use of cookies on your device.
