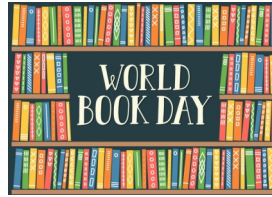
We say goodbye to our student teachers Ms Kerr, Ms Shevlin and
