

All absences need to be noted in your child's homework diary from 1st-6th and a via a note to teacher in Infants.

#### Leaving School during the day

Please come to the front door and sign your child out if s/he has to leave school during the day. It is also important to sign your child back in.

#### Roll Call

Children arriving at school later than 10:30am will be marked absent on our system, but will still be counted for attendance when giving out medals in June. No days missed merits a gold medal, and 1-2 days missed merits a silver medal.


#### Nut Free Zone


The website

# **Safety in Car Park**

In order to ensure safety and ease in the car park, please familiarise yourself and family members that may be using the car park with the following:
