## Covid-19

A reminder that the Covid-19 page on our school website is updated regularly the latest guidance from the HSE. Your child should stay at home if they:

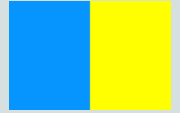
## Theatre Trip
