We will be asking for a donation at the door on the night of the concert rather than charging per seat. This money will go towards the cost of putting on the show.




There will also be a **raffle** at the interval with a very special 1st Prize of an **Amazon Fire HD8**

A penitential service for adults will take place immediately after the ceremony.


Advent Penitential Service
